

TENURED EVANGELIST INFORMATION SHEET

The following information is provided to assist you in applying for Tenured Evangelist status. Please see the *2009-2013 Manual*, “*A Tenured Evangelist... 408.3*.”

1. You must have completed four (4) full years as a Commissioned Evangelist before your District Ministerial Credentials Board may recommend you.
2. To begin the process, request a *Tenured Evangelist Application* form from your District Secretary.
3. Complete the application form and return it to your District Secretary.
4. The District Ministerial Credentials Board will consider the application. The Ministerial Credentials Board will probably want to interview you personally. If their action is to recommend you for Tenured Evangelist status, they will forward your application to The Committee on the Interests of the God-Called Evangelist, in care of Revivalism Ministries at the Global Ministry Center, 17001 Prairie Star Pkwy., Lenexa, KS 66220.
5. The Committee on the Interests of the God-Called Evangelist will make arrangements for a personal interview with the applicant. Recommendation by the District Ministerial Credentials Board does not insure that tenured status will be granted since the Committee on the Interest of the God-Called Evangelist will take tenure of involvement in full-time evangelism into consideration of their action. If the action of the committee is to approve the recommendation, they will forward your application to the Board of General Superintendents.
6. If the action of the board of General Superintendents is to approve the recommendation, they will forward your fully approved application to the Office of the General Secretary.
7. The General Secretary will notify you and your district Superintendent of your approval as a Tenured Evangelist in the Church of the Nazarene and enclose the Tenured Evangelist Certificate. Your application, with all approval signatures, will be kept on file at the Global Ministry Center. Your certification will remain valid so long as you continue to meet the qualifications for Tenured Evangelist and/or until you are granted retired status. (228.2, 433).
8. At least once every four (4) years your district superintendent will schedule and conduct a personal review with you regarding your ministry as a Tenured Evangelist.
